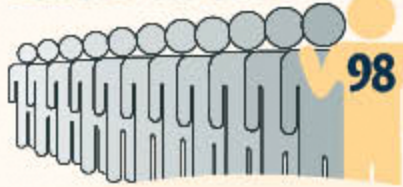

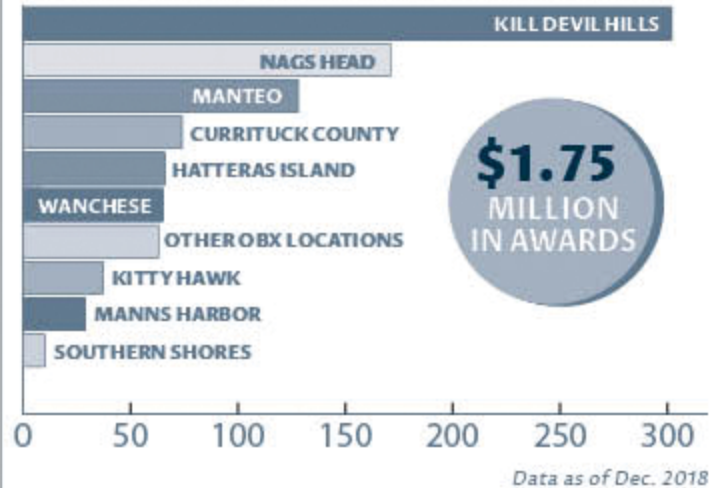
Outer Banks Sporting Events' biggest fundraiser of the year, the Outer Banks Marathon weekend, took place November 9-11. This event, spon-
